### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. GST number and PAN of the party is required.
2. No interest shall be paid on the security amount deposited by the tenderer.
3. The tenderer can participate in the e-tender by visiting e-tendering portal website i.e. [eproc.punjab.gov.in](http://eproc.punjab.gov.in). Tenderers shall upload Technical and Financial Bid on the e-tender website. Financial bids of only those parties shall be opened, which are technically qualified.
4. Expenses of agreement may be borne by the party.
5. No negotiations will be held. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
6. The party shall deposit tender fee of Rs 590/- (inclusive of GST) and it is non-refundable. The technical bid shall be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of Rs 10,000/- which shall be deposited through online mode only while submission of tender. Tender without earnest money will not be accepted. The earnest money of successful tenderers will be adjusted towards security.
7. The rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, levies, octroi etc F.O.R. supplies at Markfed MRM Nawanshahr as per design to be supplied by Markfed.
8. The rates quoted in the tenders should be both in words and figures. In the event of any dispute, prices quoted in words shall be taken final. All corrections shall be attested by the tenderer. No amendments will be allowed in prices or any other terms and conditions once the tenders are submitted to Markfed.
9. The party whose tender is accepted, will have to enter into a rate contract agreement with Markfed Modern Rice Mill Nawanshahr within a period of seven days from the acceptance of tender.
10. The party whose tender is accepted will have to deposit security amounting to Rs. 50,000 (Rs. Fifty thousand only) within ten days from the date of award of the tender. The amount of earnest money will also adjusted/adjustable towards the security.
11. The period of the contract for the supply of packing material will be one year from date of order. Markfed also reserves the right to extend the contract period beyond one year for a period of another one year or part thereof.
12. Markfed reserves the right to postpone the tender opening date. Markfed, however shall try to intimate all the tenders well in time of such postponement alongwith the revised schedule.
13. Markfed reserves the right to reject/accept tenders at their sole discretion. Any bid in whole or in the part can be rejected/accepted, even the lowest bid without assigning any reason thereof.
14. The tenderers shall supply the goods as per schedule within 20 days of the issue of the purchase order as per the directions of the Markfed. In case the party fails to supply the ordered quantity within stipulated delivery period, Markfed will be entitled to purchase packing material from the open market at the risk and cost of the supplier for which tenderer will not object. Markfed may consider to forfeit the security amount. However, Markfed may accept the late supplies after imposing a penalty @ 1% of the amount of order per week for delay upto four weeks.

15. The supply order can also be increased/decreased depending upon the requirement. The supply order can also be placed with one or two parties, for which the tenderer will not object and no cause of claim shall be made against Markfed on this account.
16. Goods shall be properly packed for dispatch. Loss due to improper packing will be debited to the supplier.
17. Goods rejected on account of quality will be lifted within 10 days by the party at their own cost. In case the same are not lifted within 15 days, expenditure incurred by Markfed shall be debited to supplier account and cost of that material will be forfeited & material will be disposed off at the risk & cost of supplier. However, the material with minor variations can be accepted with proportionate cuts.
18. All statutory obligations will be abide by the party.
19. The supplier supplying substandard material more than once may at the directions of Markfed be debarred. Further, security may be forfeited in case of supplier blacklisted by Markfed.
20. The successful tenderers shall not assign/sub-let whole or part of the order without prior consent of Markfed. Such written consent shall not however in any way relieve the contractual obligation of the supplier on whom the order was placed.
21. Inspection and material testing charges may be borne by the party.
22. In payment terms, amount of GST shall be released to the party only after the input is available to Markfed on the GST portal.
23. Tax will be deducted by Markfed in compliance of statutory provisions.
24. The Minimum requirement of turnover of supplier should be Rs.25 Lac.
25. "All the disputes and differences arising out of or in any manner touching or concerning the agreement whatsoever, shall be referred to the sole arbitration of an arbitrator to be appointed by the SPA/Markfed from the panel of the independent Arbitrators. The second party will have no objection to the appointment of the arbitrator from the panel of the independent Arbitrators Maintained by SPA/Markfed, which is in consonance with the 7th schedule of the Arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996. The award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to the contract. In the event of death of an Arbitrator or his being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reasons, the SPA/Markfed concerned at the time of such transfer, vacation of office, death or inability, shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator.  
Subject as aforesaid, the Arbitration & Conciliation Act. 1996 (as amended in 2015) or any statutory re-enactment or modifications thereof shall apply to the arbitration provided under this clause. The fee of the Arbitrator so appointed shall be governed by the terms and conditions of Markfed".
26. Corrigendum/addendum/corrections if any will be published online only.

**DELIVERY SCHEDULE:** The quantity can be increased/decreased depending upon the requirement which the party agrees to apply at the quoted rates. The packing material will be supplied in lots as per requirement of Markfed within twenty (20) days of the placement of order at Markfed Modern Rice Mill Nawanshahar. The price of the bag charged in the bill shall be inclusive all taxes and expenses.

**PAYMENT TERMS:** 80% payment will be released within seven days after receipt of material and after inspection at the factory site and if found according to the specifications, however balance payment will be released after material testing / receipt of report at our packing material testing laboratory.
