VII. ESSENTIAL COMPOSITION AND QUALITY FACTORS;

MASALA GUR, PLAIN GUR and SHAKKAR should be manufactured with best ingredients in ultra modern hygienic plant & prepared with the latest machinery which are good to taste.

VIII. PESTICIDES RESIDUES, INSECTICIDE RESIDUES & MYCOTOXINS;

MASALA GUR, PLAIN GUR and SHAKKAR should be free from pesticides residues, insecticides residues & mycotoxins in amounts which may represent a hazard to human health.

IX. HYGIENE;

It is recommended that the products covered by the provisions of this standard be prepared and handled in accordance with the appropriate section of the Recommended International Code of Practice- General Principle of Food Hygiene (CAC/RCPI-1969) and other codes of practice recommended by the Codex Alimentarius Commission which are relevant to these products.

To the extent possible in good manufacturing practice, the products shall be free from any objectionable matter.

When tested by appropriate methods of sampling and examination, the products:

- Shall be free from micro organisms in amount which may represent a hazard to health.
- Shall be free from parasites which may represent a hazard to health.
- Shall not contain substance originating from micro organisms in amount which may represent a hazard to health.

X. PACKAGING;

All packing materials (food grade) shall be as per specifications given by Markfed. The supplier shall arrange the packing material independently strictly as per the specifications and design already approved by Markfed.

XI. PRODUCTION;

The supplier shall deliver the finished product on F.O.R. Markfed Canneries, Village: Chuharwali, Tehsil: Adampur, Distt.Jalandhar as demanded by Markfed within seven days of the placement of confirmed order. In case supplier fails to supply the material within seven days, the supplier shall be liable to pay the penalty @ Rs 1.00 per carton per day for a maximum period of 15 days. After that Markfed will purchase the material from open market at the risk & cost of the supplier. The security deposited by the supplier shall be forfeited. In case of any genuine reason for late delivery such as Government restrictions on movement or any other, Chief Manager (Mktg) is authorized to waive off late delivery penalty. Masala Gur, Plain Gur and Shakkar received in defective packing or in leakage condition, material shall be replaced by the supplier at its own cost. The process of manufacturing including any process incidental or ancillary to it, shall be carried out by the producer as permitted by relevant laws. Supplier shall continuously process each lot of MASALA GUR, PLAIN GUR AND SHAKKAR.

XII. MANPOWER;

All the manpower that may be required for manufacturing and other operations including material handling etc. would be arranged by the supplier at its own cost. Markfed will not be responsible for such employees. However, Markfed can depute its quality control officer placed in the premises of supplier to check quantity / quality of product being supplied for which necessary sitting arrangements shall have to be made by the supplier and supplier

will not have any reservation to provide facility for MASALA GUR, PLAIN GUR AND SHAKKAR testing and access to the plant, stores etc. by Markfed staff.

XIII. PRICE;

Rates to be quoted by the supplier per piece, which should be F.O.R. Makrfed Canneries, Village: Chuharwali, Tehsil: Adampur, Distt. Jalandhar and GST Extra as applicable separately for local and export sale for different type of items and inclusive of all type of packing material i.e. PET Jars, inner packing, PET bottles, Labels, Wads/Sealing, Cartons & Strapping etc. and strictly as per specifications laid down. The price quoted shall remain valid for the entire period of contract.

XIV. EARNEST MONEY/ SECURITY;

Tenderer shall have to deposit Rs.590/- including GST as tender fee (non-refundable) and Rs. 50,000/- towards earnest money. The same shall be adjusted towards security. The successful tenderer shall have to deposit Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One lac only) as security in the shape of bank draft in favour of Markfed Canneries, Village Churharwali, Jalandhar, payable at Jalandhar within seven days of acceptance of offer which will be released on completion of contract and shall bear no interest. No interest shall be paid on EMD/ Security.

XV. INSPECTION/TESTING OF MASALA GUR, PLAIN GUR AND SHAKKAR;

Samples will be drawn from each and every consignment at the time of receipt of material at Markfed Canneries campus, Chuharwali by the committee constituted by Markfed in the presence of the representative of the supplier/party if present, and test will be conducted by Markfed Lab. under the procedure/method in vogue. Results so conveyed by the Markfed lab./Govt. approved lab./ accredited Laboratory will be binding on both the parties. Markfed reserves the right to get all the tests/any other test which may Markfed may deem necessary as per requirement from some reputed / accredited Laboratory. Expenditure incurred on inspection & testing shall be borne by the supplier. Its result shall also be binding on the supplier. The employee of Markfed (duly authorized by Markfed) shall be at the liberty to inspect the manufacturing premises for the purpose of quality or quantity check. In case the quality of the MASALA GUR, PLAIN GUR AND SHAKKAR are not found as per specifications, the supplier has to lift back the same immediately at their own risk & cost. In case of failure to lift the same within 7 days the storage charges @ Rs 2/- per carton per day shall incur upon the supplier for maximum of 10 days. After ward Markfed reserve the right to disposed off the rejected material at the risk & cost of the supplier and security deposited by the supplier shall be forfeited.

XVI. PAYMENT CONDITIONS;

Payment of material received for local sale will be made through R.T.G.S. only within thirty days of the receipt of each consignment subject to satisfactory inspection report. Supplier should provide complete bank details along with bank account no., I.F.S.C. code etc. Supplier should also provide self attested copies of Pan No. & GST No.

XVII. GST;

The Supplier will raise invoices to Markfed Canneries, Village Chuharwali, Jalandhar for products inclusive of the GST as applicable on F.O.R. basis at Markfed Canneries, Village Chuharwali, Jalandhar as the case may be for the quantity of finished products to be delivered under the directions of Markfed.

All Govt. taxes/levies as applicable would be deducted from the payment. Markfed reserves the right to release the payment of GST mentioned in the supply invoices only post matching of the invoices in the GSTIN system. This shall be ensured by the supplier that the invoice raised by him during a month is reported in the GST returns of the said month.

The supplier shall ensure that the invoice to be raised with Markfed is complied with the provisions of the GST Law and contains the requisite details in an accurate manner for claiming of ITC by Markfed.

Markfed reserves the right to claim from the supplier any amount of tax, interest, penalty and litigation cost, if any, that may be incurred/accrue in future due to GST reporting/compliance mistake(s) on part of the supplier.

XVIII. TDS/any other statutory taxes will be deducted by Markfed as per applicable rates according to statutory provisions.

XIX. RISK AND COST;

In case the product is found below specification, and any complaint regarding quality of Masala Gur, Plain Gur and Shakkar is reported from the Domestic/Overseas market, the supplier shall have to immediately replace the affected stock at their own expenses not later than seven days. The stock under complaint as lifted back, shall be separately stored by the party and packing material of such stocks shall be disposed off in the presence of Markfed representative to eliminate chances of its re-circulation & the party shall ensure that these stocks are not re-packed under SOHNA brand. In case such complaint of recirculation of stocks under complaint reoccurs and failure of the supplier for replacement of Masala Gur, Plain Gur and Shakkar, Markfed reserves the right to terminate the contract /agreement, make up loss/damages occurred on this account of any kind including replacement, forfeiture of security and legal action shall be taken as per the terms & conditions of the tender.

XX. STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS;

The supplier shall abide by all the regulations and Laws applicable for processing and delivery of products. The Supplier has agreed to comply with all the statutory requirements and Rules & Regulations promulgated by the Govt. (Central and State) & the local bodies from time to time for manufacture & supply of the products including packing materials in compliance with the Food Safety & Standards Act 2006 with amendments from time to time, Essential Commodities Act, BIS, Weight & Measures Act, Packaged commodity Act etc. or any such order applicable & shall be liable for any violation thereof. The supplier shall

reimburse Markfed legal expenses incurred by Markfed defending any case/prosecution on account of any omission or commission on the part of Supplier in complying with the requirements. In all such cases the Supplier will indemnify Markfed for any liabilities.

If any specific approval is required from any authority, the same will be arranged by the Supplier. The bidder must submit the above said statutory requirements with latest certificate issued

XXI. SAFETY OF GOODS:

Supplier Unit/Party will store all raw materials, packing material and products in proper sanitary condition throughout and shall ensure that they do not deteriorate or get spoiled. Any deterioration in goods due to negligence of Supplier/ Unit even during transportation/ shelf life of the product shall be the sole responsibility of the Supplier.

XXII. BLACK LISTING;

Any material supplied below specification or any complaint received regarding quality/leakage/quantity /Packing etc., shall be replaced by the supplier at his own expenses within seven days. If quality complaint of the outsourced product is received for the second time then General Manager, Markfed Canneries, Jalandhar shall out rightly proceed for black listing of the supplier and the party shall not be eligible to participate in Markfed tender for two years and security deposited by the supplier shall be forfeited.

XXIII. OFFERING OF RATES;

The Rates once offered/settled/negotiated shall not be withdrawn by the tenderer before the validity date. In the event of withdrawal, the earnest money/security of tenderer shall be forfeited and tenderer shall be debarred from participation in the next tender of Markfed and work allotted to the tenderer will be got executed from other party at his risk and cost. Conditional and incomplete tenders shall not be accepted.

XXIV. FORCE MAJEURE;

No failure by a party to perform Its obligations under the Agreement shall put that party In default or breach of its obligations under the Agreements or Impose any liability on that party for any losses or damages or delay of any nature whatsoever Incurred or suffered by the other to the extent that and for so long as the failure to perform is due solely to any event or circumstance which is beyond the control of such party which does not arise out of particular circumstance which are or should have been in the contemplation of that party at the time of entering into the Agreement and which results or causes the failure of that party to perform Its obligations under the Agreement, including act of God, as an event of Force Majeure.

Immediately following the date of commencement of any event of Force Majeure and within a reasonable time following the date of termination of such event of Force Majeure,

any party which Invoked it shall submit to the other party, a written notice of the happening of such event and reasonable proof of the nature of the event and of its effect upon the performance of the party's obligations under the Agreement.

The parties shall use all reasonable endeavours to prevent and mitigate the effects of any delay occasioned by or otherwise consequence of any event of Force Majeure.

XXV. OTHER CONDITIONS;

- a. The bidder shall sign on all the pages of these terms & conditions in view of having accepted the same and submit the scaned copy of the same online. The successful tenderer shall submit the hard copy of the signed Terms & Conditions in the office of General Manager Markfed Canneries, Village: Chuharwali, Tehsil: Adampur, Distt.: Jalandhar on demand by the plant committee. The tenderer shall also give his complete postal address with seal and mobile no.
- b. Violation of any terms & conditions of this contract shall result in the forfeiture of security and payable bills of the supplier.
- c. If the date of opening of tender happens to be holiday then the tender will be opened on the next working day without giving any separate notice.
- d. Markfed will not be responsible if the tenderer/Supplier is unable to upload/submit the tender online due to any fault or malfunctioning of the internet/e-tender site.
- e. Markfed reserves the right to accept/reject any or all tenders without assigning reason.
- f. Conditional & incomplete tenders shall not be accepted.
- g. Markfed can terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason.
- h. All the packing material lying in the factory premises shall be the property of the Supplier and shall not be taken back by Markfed in any case. Any shortage in raw material, finished goods or packing material would not be charged to Markfed at the termination of agreement. Markfed would be at liberty to take over all the finished products duly packed out of the balance stocks lying at the premises of the Supplier.
- i. In case of breach of any of the terms and conditions of the contract and the contractor withdraw himself from execution of the contract, during the pendency of agreement, Markfed reserve the right to forfeit the security deposited by the supplier and the material shall be arranged at the risk and cost of the supplier for remaining period of the agreement.

- j. In case of any change in tender documents, the corrigendum/addendum/corrections will be uploaded only at www.markfedpunjab.com and eproc.punjab.gov.in.
- k. Offers shall be valid and irrevocable for 60 days from the date of opening of tender.
- 1. The successful tenderer shall have to execute an agreement after the work is allotted to the tenderer on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 4000/-.

XXVI. ARBITRATION;

All the disputes and differences arising out of or in any manner touching or concerning the agreement whatsoever, shall be referred to the sole arbitration of an arbitrator to be appointed by the SPA/Markfed from the panel of the independent Arbitrators. The second party will have no objection to the appointment of the arbitrator from the panel of the independent Arbitrator maintained by SPA/Markfed, which is in consonance with the 7th schedule of the Arbitrators & conciliation Act, 1996. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to the contract. In the event of death of an Arbitrator or his being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reasons, the SPA/Markfed concerned at the time of such transfer, vacation of office, death or inability, shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator. Subject as aforesaid, the arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended in 2015) or any statutory re-enactment or modifications thereof shall apply to the arbitration provided under this clause. The fee of the Arbitrator so appointed shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the Markfed.

- **c.** Supplier should supply the material to meet out the requirements/specifications of above said countries.
- **d.** Successful bidder shall provide **COA** (**Certificate of Analysis**) of each and every consignment to Markfed.
- **e.** Markfed reserves the right to get all the tests/any other test which may requirement of Markfed or by our importer/concerned Geography from some reputed / accredited Laboratory. Expenditure incurred on inspection & testing shall be borne by the supplier.
- **f.** Besides of the Annexure 'A' the Terms & conditions will remain same as mentioned in the tender document however rates will be quoted separately for Local sale & export sale.
- **g.** Packaging material can be changed by Markfed at any time as per the request of our importer/concerned Geography for which the supplier shall have no objection.
- **h.** Packing should be such that it is able to bear long sea-voyages to export market without any leakage.
- i. Payment shall be made after three months from the date of receipt of material or after the receipt of the material at destination(abroad) in good condition whichever is earlier subject to satisfactory lab. Reports/ tests undertaken for export purpose.
- j. In case the product is found below specification, and any complaint regarding quality of Plain Gur and Shakkar is reported from the Overseas market, the supplier shall have to immediately supply the fresh stock at their own expenses not later than seven days. The stock under complaint can be dumped or disposed off by the concerned authorities for which the supplier shall have no objection at the risk and cost of the supplier. If complaint reoccurs and failure of the supplier for fresh supplies of Masala Gur, Plain Gur and Shakkar, Markfed reserves the right to terminate the contract /agreement, make up loss/damages occurred on this account of any kind including disposed off, replacement, forfeiture of security and legal action shall be taken as per the terms & conditions of the tender.
